

象征性亲属关系与虚拟纽带：社交媒体与群体生活在广府镇太极拳民间共同体

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摘要：太极拳传统的传承建立在一种特定的社会结构之上，该结构根植于师徒之间的礼仪化关系，并在实践共同体中象征性地再现了家族等级秩序。在这一框架内，习练者通过建立亲密的社会纽带，得以实现技术性知识的传递。随着社交媒体平台的兴起，尤其是微信的普及，太极拳习练者获得了新的互动渠道，从而重塑了共同体建构与知识传承的方式。本文以广府镇太极拳共同体为案例，探讨社交媒体在维系传统太极拳共同体以及在调节太极拳知识传承过程中的作用与意义。

Symbolic Kinship and Virtual Ties: Social media and group life in Guangfu Taijiquan communities

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Abstract: The transmission of Taijiquan traditions is structured around a specific social framework rooted in the ritualized relationship between master and disciple, which symbolically reproduces familial hierarchies within the practice community. Within this framework, practitioners cultivate intimate bonds that facilitate the transmission of technical knowledge. The emergence of social media platforms, particularly WeChat, has introduced new avenues for Taijiquan practitioners to interact, thereby reshaping modes of community formation and knowledge transmission. Drawing on a case study of Taijiquan communities in Guangfu Township, this paper examines the role and significance of social media in sustaining traditional Taijiquan communities and in mediating the transmission of Taijiquan knowledge.
